What is a Walking School Bus?

- Is my information or my child's information made public?
 - No, only program coordinators who are approved by each school's administrators are granted access to the website. Each school's SchoolPool website is password protected and cannot be accessed by other users of iCarpool, RideShareOnline, or the general public. Yours and your child's information will never be made public.
- Are parents checked for driving record, backgrounds, etc.?

 No, the SchoolPool program only identifies families who may live near each other and are traveling to school around the same time. It is the responsibility of each family to discuss arrangements.
- A walking school bus is a walking group of students led by a parent volunteer. These groups can help increase visibility of students walking, and a parent volunteer can help to make sure everyone is practicing safe walking habits. You can find more information at this link:

A bike train is a group of students who bike designated routes to school under adult supervision. Some bike trains pick up kids along the way, just like a bus; others have a central meeting point.
